

## VENUE

The Fraunhofer Institute for Chemical Technology ICT is one of over 70 applied research institutes that make up the German Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft. Fraunhofer ICT was founded in 1959. Its initial research related to only one topic: energetic materials for military applications. Today, the institute has a much wider portfolio. It has six departments that work on:

- Energetic Materials
- Energetic Systems
- Applied Electrochemistry
- Environmental Engineering
- Polymer Engineering
- New Drive Systems

The first three departments receive funding from the German Bundesministerium für Verteidigung (Federal Ministry of Defence), but this does not make up their entire revenue. All departments have contract work with industry and receive funding from other organizations such as the European Union.
